- ❖ Students are informed and advised to go through the **new NCERT textbooks** of Class IX recently published by NCERT as per CBSE new guidelines/curriculum.
- ❖ The exact reopening date of the school after summer vacation will be notified later.
- ❖ Please make sure that, your ward **remains present positively** on the reporting/reopening day after the vacation, without fail. It is mandatory for all the students to report on the reporting day to avoid the lapses in Academics.
- ❖ Students must report in proper **hairstyle and dress code** as prescribed by the school in this circular, **overleaf**.
- ❖ **It is very important, urgent & mandatory to do the re-admission process of your ward for the session 2026-27.** Many reminder and request messages have already sent for the Readmission process and Fee payment.
Please do the **Readmission** process of your ward(s) & **pay the 1ST Term Fee** as soon as possible.

Notice on Code & Conduct of Students

Hair Style:

- ✓ Students must come to School in regular hair cut i.e. combable hair style.
- ✓ Hair style should be neat & of a modest style, neither excessively long nor short.
- ✓ Length of Sideburns must be up to the upper lobes of the ears.
- ✓ Boys' hair must be off the collar at the back and off the ears.
- ✓ Student's hair must be of natural colour. No hair dye, bleach or streaking is permitted.
- ✓ Ultra-modern hair styles like multi-colored, spiked, carved designs, inappropriately long or rat tail like are strictly prohibited.
- ✓ Hair that obstructs vision or covers the face is not allowed.
- ✓ Grown up boys have to shave once in three days, depending on the growth.
- ✓ Fancy hair cut or coloring of hair is strictly prohibited.

Dress Code:

- ✓ Students must have Formal School Uniform. No student (boy) is allowed to wear the uniform with Narrow Pant of different style. Long, tight fitting or cut off pants in the uniform are not acceptable. Students with such pants will not be allowed to the class.
- ✓ Boys up to class V must wear Short Pants of the School Uniform.
- ✓ Wearing school sweater is mandatory during school hours in winter.
- ✓ Bunching or rolling of the school shirts around the waists will not be permitted. Belt must be seen from the front and the back. Shirts must be buttoned at all times.
- ✓ Hostellers are required to possess two/three pairs of school uniform, Four pairs of civil dresses, two pairs of night dresses and two pairs of sports/house uniform. More number of civil dresses are not allowed in hostel.

Unwanted Materials:

- ✓ The students must not bring any kind of unwanted materials like I-Pods, Mobile Phones, memory card, sim card, laptops, charger, Digital Watch, Cameras and other Electrical & Electronic Appliances to the School/Hostel as notified earlier. **There will be routine checking** in the class room and in the hostel. Any such things found with the students will be seized / destroyed and Strict Action will be taken against the wrong doer. Further the item confiscated from such a student would not be returned.
- ✓ Boarders are not allowed to keep cash or any valuables in their possession.
- ✓ Fancy belts, rings, ornaments, make-up sets, nail polish, hair colors etc are not allowed to school/hostel.
- ✓ Junk foods or unhealthy foods, outside Food will be completely restricted to school/hostel.
